The principal shall be responsible for assigning all students to classes.

Students who enter the system from another school system are to be placed by the principal in the grade and/or level as indicated by records from the former school. If the student's placement is inappropriate in the grade or level assigned, he/she may be reassigned by the principal to another grade level. Parents shall be kept advised.

Private School Transfers

Students entering Morgan County Schools from a Private School setting which is not state accredited must be evaluated by the school psychologist in the achievement areas of reading and mathematics to obtain a grade level placement.

Private School setting is defined as any religious related school, home school, and privately operated school without state accreditation. Migrate and homeless students may also need this service.

School records can be received by written request from other public school systems or out-of-state public systems, but if for some reason the records cannot be obtained, the school psychologist will give an achievement test in the areas of reading and mathematics.
