

DEAR PARENT OR GUARDIAN:

The Morgan County School System **does** allow corporal punishment (paddling) against any student for good cause in order to maintain discipline and order within our schools. Any principal, assistant principal or professional teacher may use corporal punishment when deemed necessary. Guidelines for corporal punishment will be as follows:

1. Only after less stringent measures have failed or if the conduct of a student is of such a nature that corporal punishment is the only reasonable form of punishment under the circumstances.
2. This is a guideline to be followed in the administering of Corporal Punishment for the school year 1991-92.

If you choose to have your child disciplined within the guidelines set forth above, please sign and return to principal of your school.
